



Zinio: Magazines on your eDevice

Get digital magazines, full color and identical to the print edition on your computer or device! Keep issues forever: once you have checked out a magazine, it is yours. No waiting lists & no due dates.


Please note: Like getting magazines from a newsstand, you must currently visit the site to download each magazine individually as it comes out. Back issues for some magazines are available and must also be downloaded individually.

Quick Instructions

1. Check out individual magazines from our special Library site with a library Zinio login.
2. Login to the main Zinio site and complete the checkout via a Zinio login (a 2nd login).
3. Read your magazines on your computer or via the free Zinio app.

Checking out Magazines

1. Open a web browser on your device. (Computer: Internet Explorer or Firefox; iDevice: Safari app; Android: Internet app)
2. Go to our library's home page: www.udpl.org and click or tap **eLibrary** then **eRead** click Zinio: eMagazines. The website will start with: <https://www.rbdigital.com/>
3. Create an account by clicking **Create New Account** in the upper right-hand corner.
4. Enter your **library barcode**. You must be a resident of Montgomery County. (Resident of someplace else? Check your home library's web site to see if they have subscribed to Zinio.)
5. Fill in your name, email and create a password.
6. Once you are logged in, you will see our walled garden of free library magazines. Some will have back issues available.
7. Click on a cover to check out that magazine. (Please note: just like getting your magazines from a newsstand, you will have to visit our walled garden library site every month/week to check out the new editions as they come out.)



8. Click **Checkout**. Then click **Start Reading**.
9. Our website will pass you to the main Zinio site. The website will start with <http://www.zinio.com/>

10. **You will need to create a second account for the main Zinio site.** Click “New? Create a Zinio account”.
 - a. For ease of use, it is recommended that you use the same email and password for both the Library’s Zinio account and the main Zinio account.
 - b. Already have a Zinio account? Use your existing account. You can then merge paid and free materials in one account.
11. Fill in your name, email & create a password. Zinio is a commercial site, so if you do not want them to email you ads, make sure to uncheck “Send me magazine discounts and Zinio news.”
 - a. Helpful hint: if you lose your check out while doing this, you can always go back to the Library’s Zinio site (<https://www.rbdigital.com/>) and click the magazine again.
12. Once you login to the app (see below), your new magazine will be waiting.

Reading your new Magazine

You may either read through the Zinio site or through the Zinio app on your tablet, phone or Windows 8 computer. *Please note: If using a phone or tablet, we recommend using the app as some tablet browsers may not display magazines correctly or at all.*

Installing the Zinio App


(Kindle Fire: See special instructions)

1. Open your device and tap the store icon to get apps. (iDevice: App store; Android: Google play store).
2. **Search for Zinio**, without the quotations.
3. **Install** the Zinio app.
 - a. iDevice: Tap free→ Install App→ Enter your Apple ID password→ Tap the Home button→ Find on Home page (it may be in a Digital Media folder)
 - b. Android device: Tap program→ Tap Install→ Skip payment page→ Accept the digital agreement→ Tap the Home/House button→ Find on Home page

Reading through the Zinio App

Internet connection not required


1. If you do not see magazine covers, tap the Magazine symbol at the top (Kindle Fire: top of screen).
2. Log into your Zinio account.
3. Magazines that are downloaded and on your device are ready to read.
 - a. (Even though you own the magazine after checkout, you will still have to download it to your device.)
4. Magazines that are not downloaded will have an arrow which you can tap to download. (for Android & iPad. Kindle devices will have the arrow next to the magazine cover.)
5. Tap the cover to start reading the magazine. Swipe to advance through the pages. Tap to the screen get the menu back.



Reading through the Zinio website

Active internet connection required

1. Login to Zinio (www.zinio.com) by clicking on the menu icon and clicking “Sign In”.
2. Your home page will be “Your Reading List” in order by newest magazine to oldest.
3. Click on a magazine’s cover. The magazine will open in a pop-up window.



4. To turn pages, you can swipe (on a tablet) or tap/click the right arrow (on a computer).



5. To print a page, click on the printer icon on the bottom. To see different layouts, click the gear for Preferences.
6. To zoom in, tap or click the portion of the page you'd like to see.

Deleting Magazines from your Device

1. Click “Edit your reading list” at the top of the screen.
2. Your magazines will appear with an x over them.
3. Tap the x to delete the magazine.
4. When you are done deleting, click “Done” at the top.
