



How can I join?



The Upper Dublin Public Library's Teen Library Council (TLC) is an advisory board made up of teens from the Upper Dublin Community who volunteer at library events, help with teen and young adult programming, and who help pick materials for the YA and Tween collection. The TLC meets monthly in UDPL's Teen Space to plan events & fundraisers, discuss books, and generally have a lot of fun!



Who can join?

TLC is open to students in grades 6-12. Members may attend any public or private school or be homeschooled.

There are three levels of TLC Membership:

Members at Large

These members are students in grades 9-12 who make up the core of TLC. They volunteer at Library and Friends' events, attend monthly meetings, and are involved in teen programs like Reading Buddies.

TLC Officer Board Members


These members are students in grades 9-12 who make up the leadership board of the TLC. Members can apply to be officers after one or more years of service and are appointed by the TLC Advisor. There are six officer positions including: President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Reading Buddies Coordinator, Jr. Officer.

Junior Members

These members are students in grades 6-8 who want to be involved with TLC but due to their age, may not be eligible for all volunteer opportunities.
