HOW IT WORKS

The Seed Library was established for our community to borrow, share & sow seeds.

Unlike a regular library, the seeds you borrow are yours to keep. However, the library welcomes saving seeds from your harvest to donate back to the collection.



HOW TO BORROW

Simply fill in the "Checkout Log" with your name, type of seeds & number of packets you are taking. Please take only what you need.

Each labeled seed envelope contains three or more seeds of the same variety.

Seeds must be in good condition in a sealed envelope with the following information written on it:

Common Name, Height, Color, Vegetable/Flower/Herb, Growing Season, Year Collected Annual/Perennial, Your Name (optional).

Drop off donated seeds at the drive-thru Pick Up Window, Express Desk or 2nd floor Main Desk.

Will NOT accept: bulbs, bareroot, tubers, hemp/cannabis or datura/moon flower .
