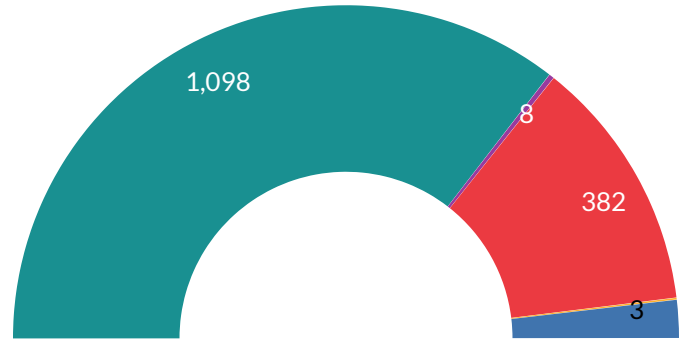
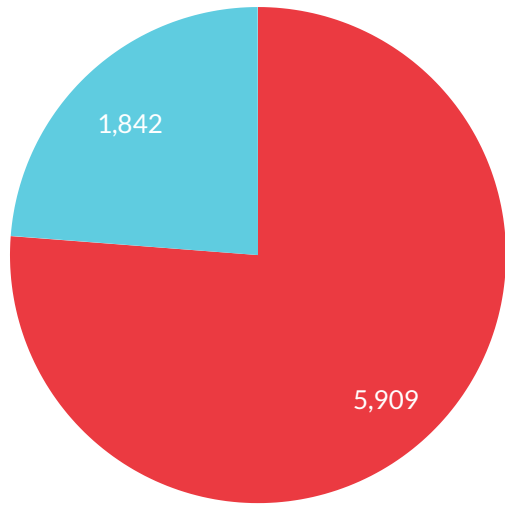

CIVIC ENGAGEMENT @ THE LIBRARY 2022

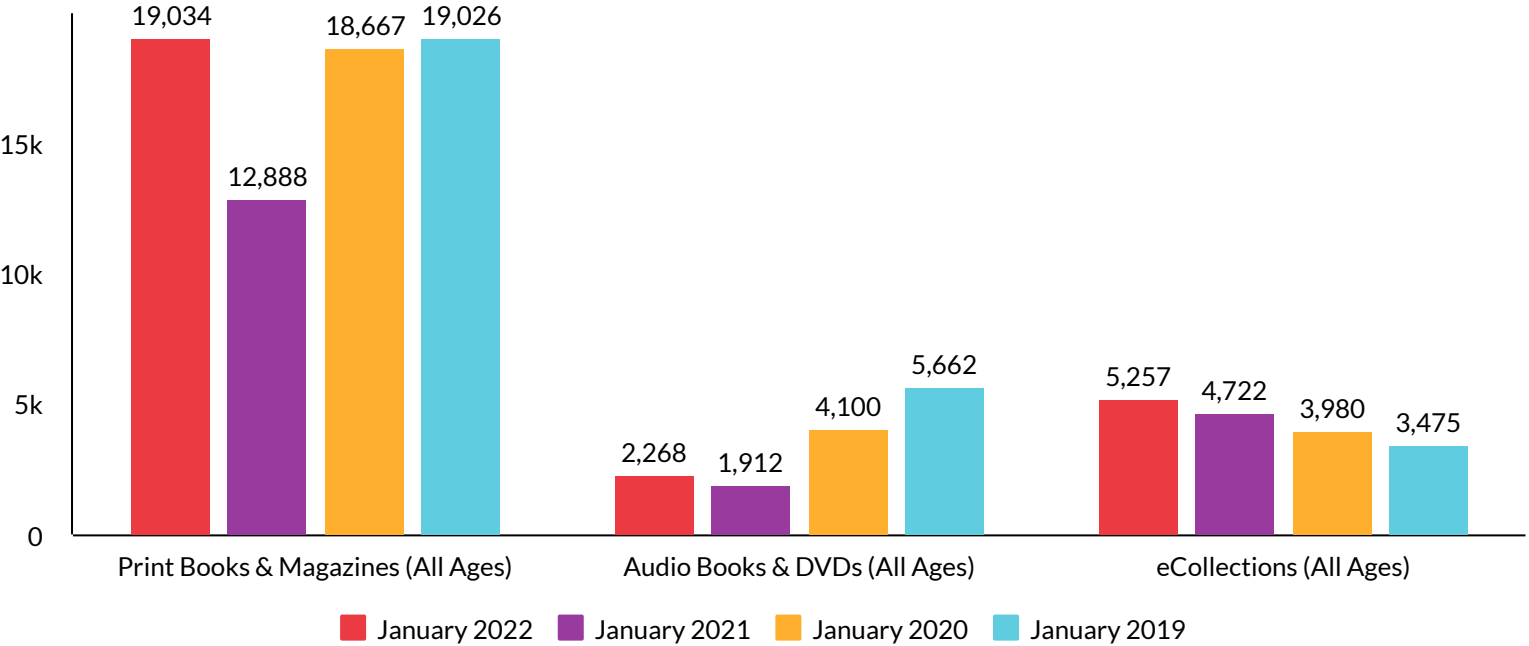
Inspired by the Library’s new role as host to Upper Dublin Township’s governmental meetings, the Library staff are planning now for a series of programs to begin this spring focused on **Civic Engagement @ the Library**, which emphasizes the role of the library as a place where residents have the information they need to fulfill their civic responsibilities and support democracy. The programs held throughout the year will engage audiences in discussions of US citizenship, civic responsibilities, democracy, and, generally, examine the stories of what it means to be American from diverse perspectives and presented through a variety of mediums, including writing, music, film and art.

This programming also supports PA Forward (<https://paforward.org/>), the Pennsylvania Library Association’s 21st Century Literacy Initiative, which identifies civic and social literacy as one of its five pillars of knowledge essential for success. The UDPL recently applied for a grant through the American Library Association, the funds of which would be used to support this programming effort; selections will be announced shortly. 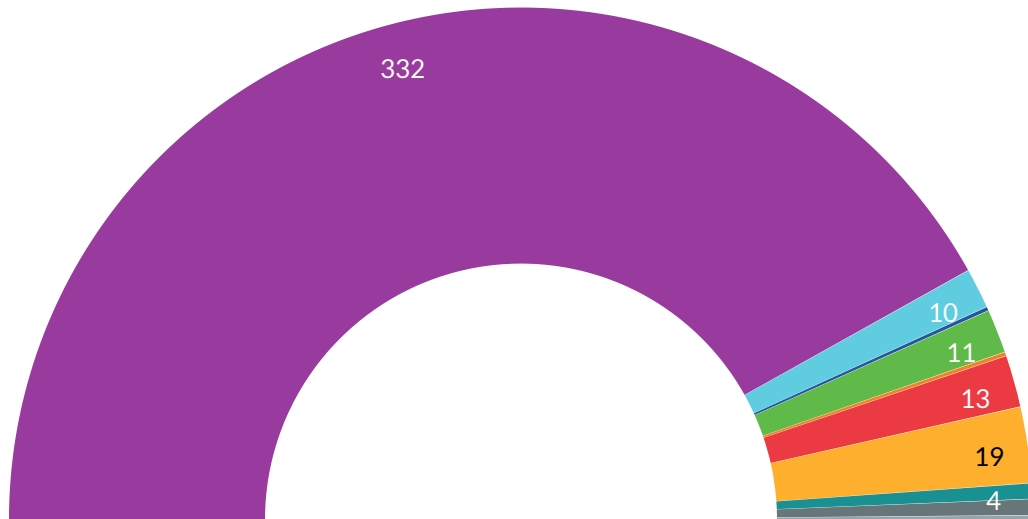

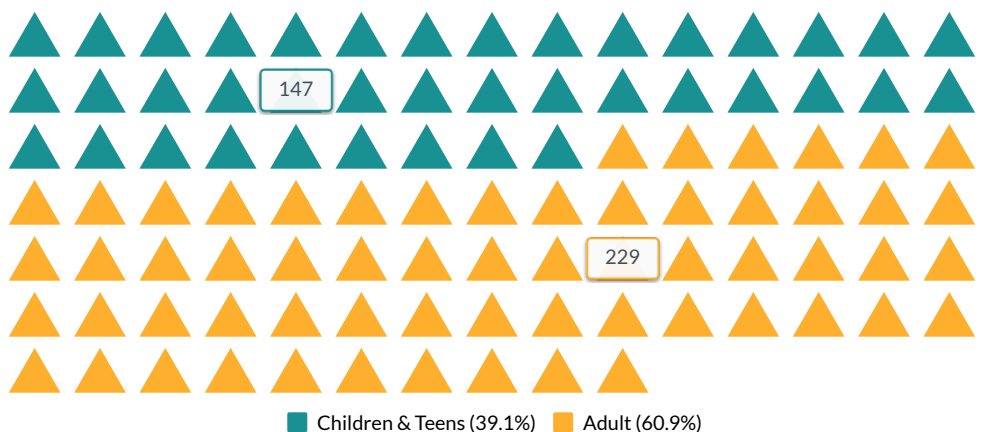
